**§C2-10. City Purchasing Agent**

**B.** Competitive bidding is required in all situations where so designated under the provisions of the General Municipal Law and in all other situations where required by the City Council.

**§C2-10. City Purchasing Agent**

**B.** Competitive bidding is required in all situations where so designated under the provisions of the General Municipal Law, ***including the "best value" provision, (GML Sec. 103)*** and in all other situations where required by the City Council.

**LOCAL LAW 05-2015 AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF PURCHASE CONTRACTS ON THE BASIS OF BEST VALUE**

**BE IT ENACTED** by the CITY OF GLEN COVE of the COUNTY OF NASSAU as follows:

**SECTION 1. Preamble.**

A. Section 103 of the General Municipal Law requires competitive bidding for purchase contracts and public works contracts and has historically required that such bids be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder whose bid meets the requirements of the specifications for the project.

B. Section 103 was recently amended to provide that by enacting a Local Law so providing, counties and other municipalities may award purchase contracts which would otherwise be subject to the "lowest bidder" rule on the basis of best value, as defined in Section 163 of the State Finance Law, to a responsive and responsible bidder or offeror.

C. The City of Glen Cove hereby determines that it is in the best interest of the City and its residents for the City Council to have the authority to award purchase contracts on the basis of best value.

**Add:**

**§ C3-3.1 Authorization.**

A. On and after the effective date hereof, the City of Glen Cove may award purchase contracts, including contracts for service work, but excluding any purchase contract necessary for the completion of a public works contract pursuant to Article 8 of the Labor Law, on the basis of best value, as defined in Section 163 of the State Finance Law, to a responsive and responsible bidder or offeror.

B. The election to award any such contract on the basis of best value shall be made by the City Council, which authorizes the solicitation for bids therefore.

C. The City Purchasing agent shall develop procedures that will govern the award of contracts on the basis of best value. These procedures shall be included in the City of Glen Cove Procurement Policy.

D. In the event that no such election is made, purchase contracts will continue to be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder furnishing the required security in accordance with the City of Glen Cove Procurement Policy.

**§ C3-3.2 Severability.**

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this local or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, effect or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this law or in its application to the person, individual corporation, firm, partnership, entity or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

This local law shall become effective immediately upon the filing with the New York Secretary of State.


